

## New City Catechism

**Question 10:** What does God require in the fourth and fifth Commandments?

**Answer:** Fourth, that on the Sabbath day we spend time in worship of God. Fifth, that we love and honor our father and our mother.

Leviticus 19:3

### Begin by reading Leviticus 19:3

This week the 10 Commandments seem to shift in their focus. Review the first 4 on your fingers.

- What do these 4 focus on? (*Our relationship with God—worshipping God properly*)

Now review 5-10.

- What do these 6 focus on? (*Our relationships with others*)
- What happens if we don't do our best to obey the first 4? (*Makes it nearly impossible to obey the next 6!*)

### Commandment 4:

- What is the Sabbath? (*“Sabbath” means rest. It is the cessation of activities proper to the other 6 days in order to set apart 1 day to the Lord*)
- Why do you think God included this one in the Commandments? (*For our own good—to rest our bodies, our spirits and our souls and to rely and trust in His provision.*)
- How can we make the Sabbath a priority in our family?

### Commandment 5:

- As God transitions from our relationship with Him to our relationship with others, which is the first relationship he addresses?
- Why do you think He starts here?
- What does it mean to “honor” someone? (*to show high regard and respect for, to accept their authority*)
- Since God commands us to honor, how are we to treat our parents?

Review all 10 Commandments before closing your time in prayer.
