

## New City Catechism

Question 9: What does God require in the first, second, and third Commandments?

Answer: First that we know God as the only true God.  
Second, that we avoid all idolatry.  
Third, that we treat God's name with fear and reverence.

Deuteronomy 6:13-14

Begin by reading Deuteronomy 5:6-11

- Why do you think these are the first 3 out of the 10 Commandments?

Review the First, Second and Third Commandments using your fingers (see last week's lesson).

For older ones – Read the Commentary section from the New City Catechism app or website for question 9 and then discuss. Make sure your kids understand what Spurgeon is saying. Look at the dates in which Spurgeon lived? What has changed?

For all ages – What is idolatry? (The worship of a symbol or representation of a god or deity or the adoration of a person or thing that is not God) Discuss examples of this in our world or even our lives.

How can we treat God's name with fear and reverence?  
How do we NOT honor His name? (The app video is helpful here).

Read Matthew 6:21

- What do these words from Jesus have to do with these 3 Commandments?
